- The boosters will be providing a meal at 11:30 am on Sunday for the Marching Band prior to their departure to Hershey for Cavalcade of Bands Championships. The meal will include: hotdogs, pulled pork, chili, baked potato bar, chips and water. We are asking for donations of baked goods for dessert. These can be dropped off on Saturday at the school. If families would like to join the band for the meal, we're asking that they sign up on sign up genius by Wednesday 11/6. Please include the number of people in your family who will be eating with the band.
- The boosters will also provide a meal for the students at Hershey following their performance. This meal will include a sandwich, apple or orange, chips, dessert and water.

12. Holiday Concerts

- Tickets go on "sale" Nov. 18th. These will be reserved seats. Please only take the number of tickets that you know you are going to use. An email will be sent out with link to "purchase" tickets.
- Concerts are Sat. 12/14 at 1:30pm & 7:30pm and Sun. 12/15 at 2:30pm.
- We will be needing help on concert days with ticketing, bake sale table, ushers etc. Please contact Aileen Hower if you are able to help.
- A meal will be served to all high school music department members between the Saturday afternoon and evening holiday concerts. High school members are not permitted to leave the building between the concerts. LaCucina has agreed to cater the meal which will consist of Chicken parmesan, penne pasta with marinara sauce, Italian bread with cheese, salad and water. We will need volunteers to help setup, serve, and clean up after the meal. We will also be asking for dessert donations for approximately 270 people. A motion was made by Debi Jemison to accept the max expense for this meal to be \$2,500. This was seconded by Marilee Klunk. Membership approved the spending of \$2,500 on this meal.

13. Adopt a Family

14. Dance Recital

- Fund raising opportunity- The Music Boosters have been asked to provide concessions for 2 dance recitals on June 13th. Prior attendance at these performances has been about 800-1,000 people. Boosters would get 100% of the profit. After more details have been obtained about this event, a vote will be taken to accept or decline this opportunity. Comments at tonight's meeting were favorable. Concessions would consist of candy, baked goods, water and soda.

16. Directors comments:

- Friday 11/9/19 the Symphonic Band and Concert Choir will perform for area veterans. There will be rehearsal after school on Wednesday and before school on Thursday.
- Solo auditions for the Holiday Concerts will be held on November 14th.
- All music students must complete their rhythm assessment by 11:59 pm on 11/15/19 or they will be assessed a music department detention on Monday 11/18/19 after school. Students will need to stay until their rhythm assessment has been completed.
- Fall Play "The Three Musketeers" will be performed Thursday 11/21/19 – Saturday 11/23/19
- Dress Rehearsal for the holiday concerts is Tuesday 12/10/19 at 6pm. Students may leave after they have completed their portion of the concert. Students are permitted to stay in the auditorium to watch the remainder of the dress rehearsal if they wish.
- Poinsettia sale is happening now through November 22nd. The proceeds from this sale will help TriM to present scholarships to deserving SWHS Music students. These may be purchased in honor or in memory of a loved one, family member or friend. The goal is to sell at least 1 poinsettia for each student participating in the holiday concerts. Those who purchase poinsettias may take them home with them following the holiday concert.
- Legacy Club is going strong. Approximate \$5,000 received in 2019. Many are repeat donors. A suggestion was made for a donor recognition mural/plaque to be designed like the bronze tree that recognizes teachers for 10+ years of service. A prime location for this structure would be

on the wall outside the auditorium. It was also discussed that a sample of the design could be hung stating "future home of legacy club donor wall." Design to be determined.

- Mustang Vision is looking of sponsorship again this year to help purchase new equipment. There is no budget for Mustang Vision. They rely totally on donations/sponsorships. Discussion was had about whether to sponsor holiday concerts and/or graduation. Sponsorship would include our logo on the screen throughout the program and a commercial about legacy club during intermission. Mrs. McKee will get more information and ask Mr. Myrdal to attend an upcoming booster meeting. A motion to sponsor live stream of concerts and graduation with cost to be determined was made by Tom Jemison and seconded by Keith Garrett. Membership approved sponsorship of Mustang Vision for concerts and graduation.
